2016 REGISTRATION FEES

Below, please find the information pertaining to the 2016 Individual and Organisational Membership Registration Fees:

The **closing date** for re – registrations of gymnasts/officials that have been registered before, are as follows:

Clubs/schools/community Centre: **Wednesday, 17 February 2016**

Gymnasts & officials: **Thursday, 17 March 2016**

The **closing date** for registrations of new competitive members is: **Friday, 27 May 2016**

Gymnasts moving clubs need to complete and sign the transfer form, before registering on the system. The transfer form needs to be signed by both clubs. PLEASE NOTE: Gymnasts can only be registered on the system once.

A late registration penalty of 50% will be charged by SAGF for previously registered Gymnasts registering after the above date. Non-competitive members can be registered throughout the year, without penalty.

Please note that the Development Levy will not be charged by the Western Cape Gymnastics Association. Your district will be in contact with you on this and each district will be determining its own levy and managing and administering it themselves.

Individual Membership

Category A = Competitive = R425.00

This is a gymnast who is involved in any discipline under the auspices of SAGF from Level 1 upwards (all competitive levels).

If a gymnast is wishing to compete at district, provincial or national events they must be registered in this category.

This is a coach who is qualified from Level 1 and higher and runs classes on their own.

SAGF receives R240.00, Province receives R135.00, Club receives R50.00

Category B = Non-Competitive = R55.00 total

This is a gymnast who is involved in any program in the sport at a level below Level 1 (Recreational). This includes awards schemes, Gym For All programs, Group Leagues etc. This includes pre-schoolers participating in clubs and satellite pre-schools. A gymnast may not compete in a SAGF program if they are registered in this category.

This is a coach who is qualified as Elementary or GL coach and works as an assistant coach.

If a member is only a judge they register as a category B.

This is a Supporter.

This category is purely non-competitive and makes no distinction between whether a member comes from an advantaged or disadvantaged background.

SAGF receives R26.00, Province receives R19.00, Club receives R10.00

Category C = Competitive (PDI) = R55.00

This is a gymnast who is involved in any discipline under the auspices of SAGF from Level 1 upwards (all competitive levels) who is classified by their District/Province as coming from a current financial disadvantaged background.

If a gymnast is wishing to compete at district, provincial or national events, they must be registered in this category.

Each year there seems to be more and more Category C gymnasts. Category C is supposed to be allocated in exceptional cases of hardship only. The individual does not have to be a previously disadvantaged individual, but rather an individual currently experiencing financial hardship.

PLEASE NOTE: ALL CAT C REGISTRATIONS HAVE TO BE APPLIED FOR VIA WCGA. Application form attached.

Category D = School participant = R0 total

This is a gymnast who is involved in any discipline under the auspices of SAGF that is taught at their school. If a gymnast is registered in Category D they may only compete in an Inter Schools League Competition. If a gymnast wishes to compete in a SAGF competition they must upgrade to a Category A or C member. This is a coach or judge who is an educator who only coaches or judges in a school and at Inter Schools League Competitions.

Life Member = R1 500.00 total

This is a member who wishes to be registered with the Federation for their lifetime.

This is a once off payment and does not have to be repeated again.

SAGF receives R1 500.00, Province receives R0, Club receives R0

Organisational Membership

Category A = Competitive Organisation = R1 300.00 total

This is a club that is involved in any program discipline under the auspices of SAGF from Level 1 upwards (all competitive levels).

SAGF receives R150.00, Province receives R1150.00

Category B = Non-Competitive Organisation or Institution = R200.00 total

This is a club that is involved in any program in the sport at a level below Level 1 (Recreational). This includes awards schemes, Gym For All programs, Group Leagues etc.

This includes operators who service preschools. The preschool is registered in this category and the number of gymnasts is recorded on a table at no charge.

This category is purely non-competitive and makes no distinction between whether a club is from an advantaged or disadvantaged background.

SAGF receives R70.00, Province receives R130.00

This is a club that is involved in any discipline under the auspices of SAGF from Level 1 upwards (all competitive levels) who is classified by their District as coming from a current financial disadvantaged background.

PLEASE NOTE, ALL CAT C CLUB REGISTRATIONS HAVE TO BE APPLIED FOR VIA WCGA, UNLESS THE CLUB HAS AN NPO CERTIFICATE.

SAGF receives R70.00, Province receives R130.00

Category D = School = R0 total

This is a school that is involved in any discipline under the auspices of SAGF that is only taught at that school. They also only compete in Inter Schools League Competitions. The School is registered in this category and the number of gymnasts per discipline is recorded on a table at no charge.
